13 - Intellectual

An intellectual disability involves limitations in intellectual functioning and adaptive behaviour, originating before the age of 18.

14 - Learning

Learning disabilities refer to difficulties in acquiring and using skills such as listening, speaking, reading, writing, reasoning, or mathematics. These may affect learning across the lifespan.

15 - Mental Illness

Mental illness refers to psychological or emotional conditions that affect thinking, behaviour, or mood and may impact daily functioning.

16 - Acquired Brain Impairment

Acquired brain impairment refers to damage to the brain occurring after birth, resulting in changes to cognitive, physical, emotional, or independent functioning. Causes may include trauma, illness, or neurological conditions.

17 - Vision

Vision impairment includes partial or total loss of sight, including blindness. It may be present from birth or acquired.

18 - Medical Condition

A medical condition may be temporary or ongoing and can affect a person's physical or mental wellbeing (e.g. asthma, diabetes, chronic illness). These conditions may fluctuate in severity.

19 - Other

A disability, impairment, or long-term condition not covered by the categories above. This includes conditions such as autism spectrum disorder
